On 25 April 1915, our military forces demonstrated that Australians possessed outstanding qualities of courage, determination and patriotism. Gallipoli gave Australians their freedom and their independence by giving them their first sense of nationhood.

With incredible perseverance, the ANZACs established a tenuous foothold on the steep slopes above the beach and for eight months struggled to survive in the face of a determined enemy and under appalling conditions.

Thirty years later, another generation of Australians was celebrating the end of a second world war, many having suffered equally horrendous conditions as those who went before them.

This medallion commemorates these two anniversaries as being representative of the struggle and sacrifice of all Australians who have served their country in times of conflict.
